This slipped my mind. I've graduated and have since moved onto the working world. Here's a brief summary of what I used the funds for. I hope this suffices.

- x In the summer of 2021, I worked with Professor Jacky Baughman (Earth and Oceanographic Sciences) to reconstruct the 600 million year thermal history of the granite structures underlying the area around Boston, Massachusetts. The following December, with support from the Grua O'Connell Grant, I attended the American Geophysical Union national fall meeting in New Orleans. There, I met a handful of student researchers conducting similar work in thermochronometry and was able to exchange our experiences of learning from talented faculty members. I also got to see many presentations on research as diverse as Texas winter storm responses, Alaskan wildfires, and environmental justice in the US south. Finally, I presented my summer research in a hybrid format to a forum of experts in the tectonics field and responded to questions on my study. I look forward to taking these lessons from New Orleans with me as I go on to graduate work in Venice, Italy.
